## Tasting Notes:

100% Malbec, the 2006 is a deep inky red with juicy dark fruit and soft tannins. Rich and inviting aromas of black licorice and dark cherries dominate the nose. Nice ripe fruit with lush flavors of dark plums and mocha that are enhanced by full rich textures that lead to a long satisfy finish. This exotic and powerful red will age gracefully for the next 10 years.
